MISSION STATEMENT

The program is a comprehensive and strategic solution that will ensure to uphold and promote public SAFETY and SECURITY through integration and utilization of highly advance technology and communication tools, as well as security expert, trained technical and patrol personnel that can assist on a wide range operation, monitoring and supervision of identified critical and unprotected areas, provide immediate response and support to emergency and other related events that would require once attention of other agencies



INTELMAXIMUM Department of Public Safety

Maintains a close working relationship with local enforcement agencies. Function is a 24-hour-a-day, seven days-a-week, service-oriented operation. IMSI officers work closely with Sta. Cruz Local Government Units and Police Force. Make every reasonable effort to follow up on crimes referred to them. Less-serious incidents and violations of local regulations are investigated by the Kabayan Anti-Crime Group – Seniors, KIF-ACU, LGU Monitoring Group and referred to local Barangay Captain as necessary. Any local citizen is free to report any matter directly to the appropriate local police authority and is provided instructions on how to do so.



Staffing

Several interrelated sections make up the department, including the patrol units, which consist of ATV, foot patrol and the police communication center. The communications center handles all radio communications and calls for service. The center monitors the closed-circuit television cameras, the alarms and the emergency calls.

Communications Center

The Communications Center, as part of the Public Safety Department, receives and dispatches calls for service 24 hours a day, 365 days a year. A communication specialist may be contacted from any field support phone. Communication specialists are responsible for disseminating information to officers, directing calls for police service, coordinating emergencies, dispatching escorts, and monitoring the alarm and access control systems.

Patrol Unit

The Department of Public Safety is responsible for providing protection and service to the local community. IMSI ATV personnel perform motor vehicle patrol. The Auxiliary Constable Program (Kabayan Anti-Crime Group –Seniors, KIF-ACU, LGU Monitoring Group) covers the strategic areas in two ways: on foot and at fixed posts (covered in three shifts: 6AM-2PM, 2PM-10AP and 10PM-6AM). An officer is assigned to each patrol beats during a 24-hour period. The department uses a problem-oriented, community-based philosophy.

An event report is prepared for criminal offenses and noncriminal incidents.

The Municipal Police Department of Sta. Cruz Zambales is immediately notified in all cases of serious felonies.
